We understand what we need to do to improve in our learning. We know what makes our learning 'stick'.

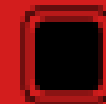
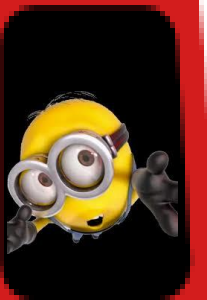
