Last Day at School

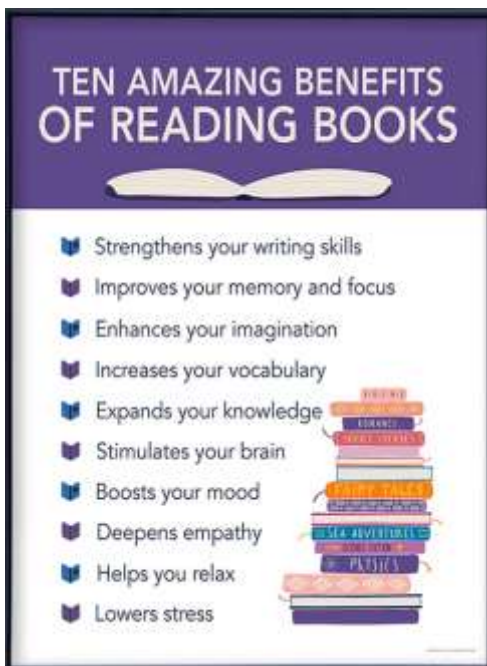

Uniform

Our school uniform is important. What a child wears to school reflects his/her learning. It also portrays the school's ethos and shared positive values. We have a smart but simple uniform that, from September 2021, we expect all pupils to wear (Our Royal Blue uniform can still be worn also).
