If you pull into the school gateway to drop your child off in the morning, please stop this – It is extremely selfish and puts our children in danger.

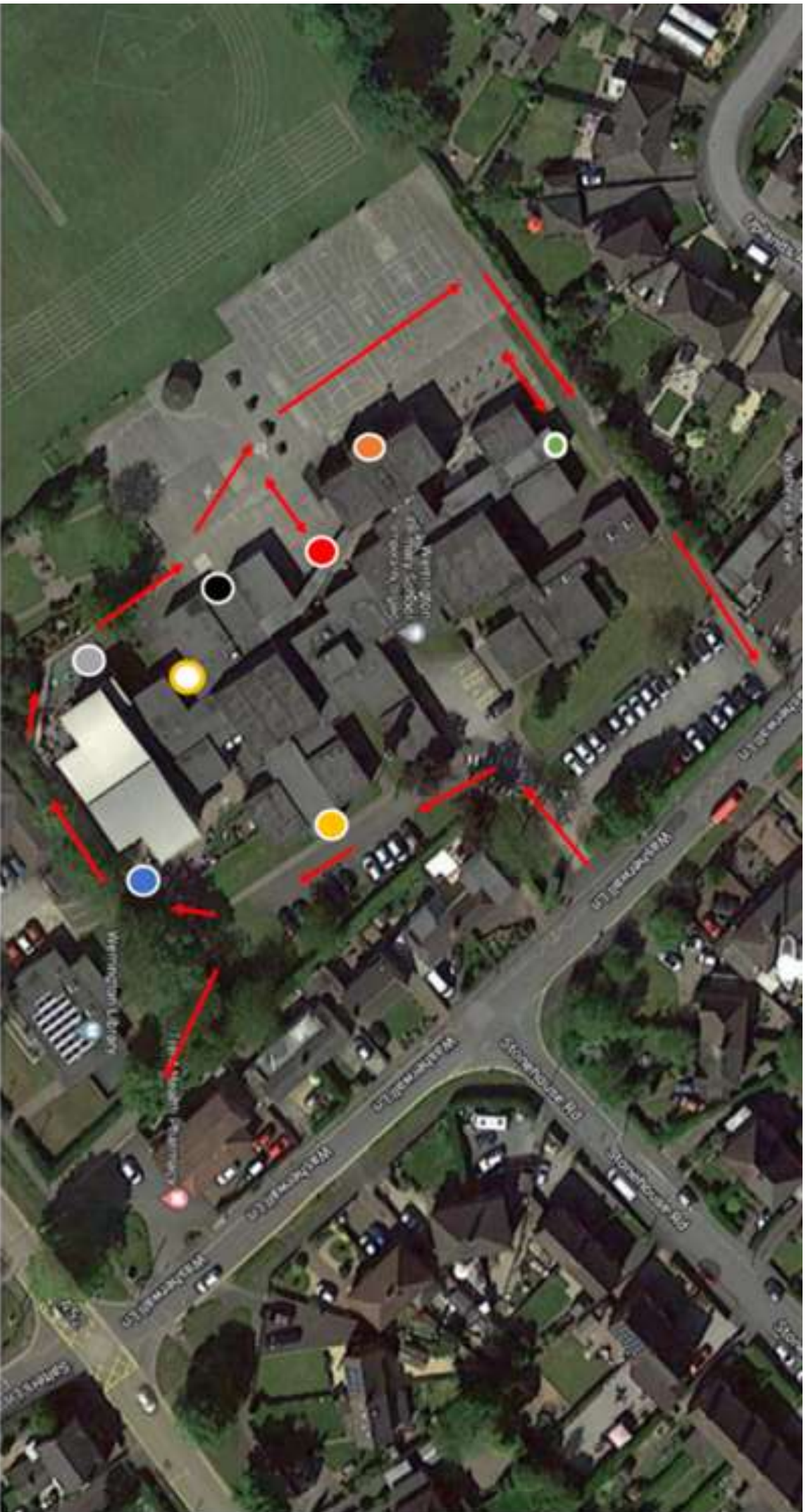
### Could you foster?
