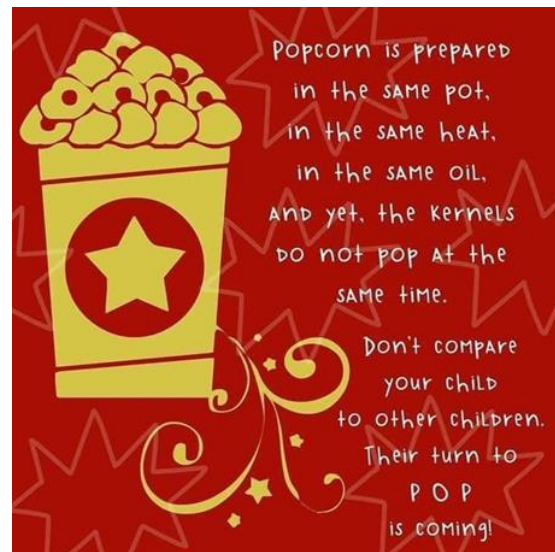
Parents Evening
