**If your child is ready to start in our Reception class in September 2021, you will need to apply for a place – even if your child currently is in our Nursery.**

### IMPORTANT

If you, or anyone in your household, shows symptoms of Coronavirus, please ensure that the whole household self-isolates until the person with symptoms has a test and that test produces a 'negative' result. **DO NOT send your child into school if you have symptoms of Covid-19.**

### Christmas Dinner

Christmas dinner day will be Wednesday 16<sup>th</sup> December – dinners must be pre-ordered on Parentpay - there will be no other food options on this day from the canteen.



We are also having a special 'All Day Breakfast' menu on Tuesday 1<sup>st</sup> December which can be ordered on Parentpay.

### Christmas Cards

We've been taking advice on what to do about Christmas cards this year. I'm pleased to be able to offer the following options to parents who wish to send cards into school.

**Option A** - individual cards sent in to school by **Tuesday 8<sup>th</sup> December** which are placed in a box in the classroom and quarantined for 72 hours, the teacher would then sanitise and give these out to children to go straight home.

**Option B** - the child makes one big card for the whole class which is displayed in the classroom.

Options A and B are for pupils in Key Stages 1 and 2. We ask that pupils in the early years take Option B only.
